To be eligible to undertake clinical practice experience, students are required to provide the School of Nursing & Midwifery – UTAS the following documents:

**1. National Criminal History Record Check (NCHRC)**

Students are required to obtain less than six-months-old National Criminal History Record Check from NSW Police force by completing Form P799 Application for a National Criminal History Record Check (Standard disclosure) for more information, please check website:

**2. Adult Vaccination Record Card**

Students are required to complete the adult vaccination card before being allowed to enter a clinical practice arena. You will be provided with full information including a NSW Health Vaccination card at orientation. The required vaccinations are:

- Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussie acellular (dTpa) Vaccine
- Hepatitis B Vaccine
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) Vaccine
- Varicella (Chickenpox) Vaccine
- Tuberculin skin test (Mantoux)
